1/ Print culture has popularized the ideas of enlightenment thinkers. The writings of these thinkers such as ^{2/} (Thomas Paine, Voltaire and Rousseau were widely printed and read during the times. Collectively, their writings provided a critical commentary on tradition, superstition and despotism.) ^{1/} They argued for the rule of reason rather than custom and demanded that everything be judged through the application of reason and rationality.) ^{3/} (They attacked the sacred authority of the Church and the despotic power of the state. Thus eroding the legitimacy of a social order based on tradition.) ^{3/} The writings of Voltaire and Rousseau were read widely : and those who read. These books saw the world through new eyes, which were critical and rational.
